WOMEN'S RETREAT

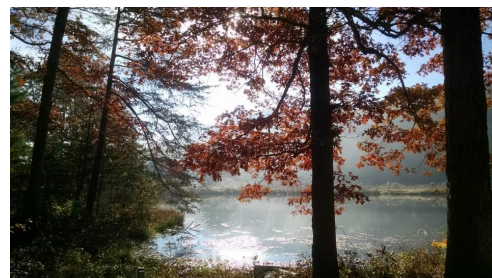
“The Command of Love” 1John 4:19-21

1. Cost is \$35.00/person.

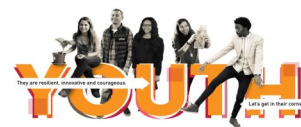
